## *Who We Are*

**Agape-Heart International Organization (AHIO) is a non-governmental and non-partisan humanitarian Christian organization located in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, with satellite offices in Nashville, Tennessee; Des Moines, Iowa, and a field office in Arua, Uganda, and in Juba, South Sudan.**

**AHIO offers a wide range of services to refugees, internally displaced persons in war-torn countries (South Sudan) the poor, low income, working classes, support for people living with HIV/AIDS, homeless (i.e., teenagers, vulnerable girls and children) in Africa and other parts of the world, regardless of race, sex, gender identity, age, nationality, citizenship, or any other class of people who are struggling in their new living places.**

**The idea for this organization arose from the founder's personal experience of growing up as orphaned in South Sudan and other places in Africa, where in general there is great hostility among people because of greed and ignorance.**



**Civil Wars in some of these countries have lasted for generations and have exposed children to the terrors of war, creating immense hardships. These hostilities have destroyed the love of God among these children, ruined their country's development and have created a life of poverty for the citizens.**
